


How to Earn Money for Southminster Using Amazon Smile

Amazon will donate 0.5% of the purchase price of eligible purchases to the eligible charity of your choice if you 1) designate the charity of your choice, and 2) complete your purchase on the Amazon Smile website (smile.amazon.com). Participation in this program costs you nothing, as smile.amazon.com features the same prices as the regular Amazon.com website. We hope you will choose Southminster as your charity!


The following instructions show you how to set up Southminster as your choice for the Amazon Smile program:

1. Direct your browser to <https://smile.amazon.com>




Note that you must always do your shopping here, at *smile.amazon.com*, and not the more usual *www.amazon.com*.

2. Login to your Amazon.com account in the usual way.
3. You should see a banner similar to this:



Click on the link that says "Visit AmazonSmile."

4. Amazon will ask you to start by choosing a charity. Enter "southminster presbyterian" in the text box and click the "Search" button.



5. The search results will show several churches named Southminster Presbyterian Church, so make sure that you find the one located in Beaverton, OR, and click on the “Select” button for that one!

Choose from almost a million charities, schools, and other nonprofits. We will reach out to the organization you select to ensure it is ready to accept donations from Amazon.
