HEBREW TESTAMENT READING

Rev. Common Lectionary Isaiah 6:1-8

In the year of King Uzziah's death, I saw the Almighty sitting on a high and exalted throne, the edges of God's robe filling the temple. Winged creatures were stationed around God. Each had six wings: with two they veiled their faces, with two their feet, and with two they flew about. They shouted to each other, saying: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of heavenly forces! All the earth is filled with God's glory!" The doorframe shook at the

sound of their shouting, and the house was filled with smoke. I said, "Mourn for me; I'm ruined! I'm a person with unclean lips, and I live among a people with unclean lips.
