Matthew 3:1-12

Prepare the way of the Lord, make God's paths straight."

"I baptize you with water for repentance, but God who is coming after me is mightier than I. whose sandals I am not worthy to carry; God will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire. God's winnowing fork is in God's hand, and God will clear his threshing floor and gather God's wheat into the granary, but the chaff God will burn with unquenchable fire.."
