Participants must be 14 years old, unless accompanied by a parent or signatory guardian.

CONTINUAL DISASTER RELIEF NEEDS IN PR

On September 20, 2017, life changed for millions of people living in Puerto Rico (PR). That's when Hurricane Maria, packing winds in excess of 155 miles per hour, slammed into the island. The Category 4 storm left millions homeless, destroyed the island's power grid, and killed thousands. Presbyterian Disaster Assistance (PDA) and Lutheran Disaster Response (LDR) have been walking alongside leaders of the island since before the hurricane.

Our group will also be partnering with a local church or churches in the development of a children's program and/or community outreach events. On most evenings, we will hear from a Puerto Rican living on the island as they share insights about topics such as: immigration and undocumented workers, political realities in PR, history of the island and its culture and economic concerns and current realities.

Our Southminster intergenerational mission trip will seek to plant seeds of kindness and understanding while making peace around the world. The kick-off for this mission trip will be January 30, 2022 with registration and deposit due on February 13, 2022. We invite you to prayerfully consider joining us in making peace across the globe.

LODGING

We will be staying at the Lutheran Camp Eduardo Roig, which is operated by Lutheran Social Services of Puerto Rico. The camp facilities are about 15 miles west of San Juan and is used to accommodate volunteers helping in disaster response efforts.

EXPENSES & REQUIREMENTS

INDIVIDUAL COST

YOUTH = \$800

PARENTS & COLLEGE STUDENTS = \$1,200

ADULTS = \$1,400

SCHOLARSHIPS MAY BE AVAILABLE WHILE THE EXPECTED TOTAL COST OF THE TRIP IS APPROX. \$2,250 (INCLUDES AIRFARE, LODGING, TRANSPORTATION, FOOD, AND ACTIVITIES), INDIVIDUALS WILL PAY THE COST ABOVE.

ONCE AIRLINE TICKETS ARE PURCHASED IN THE SPRING, REFUNDS WILL NOT BE GIVEN.
