## **Worship & Preaching**

- Lead worship services and administer sacraments in accordance with PC(USA) polity
- Deliver biblically grounded, theologically liberal sermons that are both spiritually uplifting and thought provoking
- Seek input from the Worship Committee regarding order of worship, special services, scheduling communion, and participation of the laity
- Provide opportunities for congregants to be involved in a shared ministry of preaching, worship, education, personal and spiritual growth, congregational support, and world community involvement
- As the theological leader of Southminster, encourage church life and education that is open, inclusive, and challenging to the congregation

#### **Pastoral Care**

- Provide support for pastoral care through the Deacons
- Provide crisis care, visitation, and counseling for the church community, which includes members and non-members
- Officiate at sacraments of Baptism and Communion and at special events such as weddings, memorial or funeral services, and others as requested by the Session

#### **Transitional Tasks**

- Help the congregation reflect on its identity, mission, and future direction
- Assist in preparing the church for the pastoral search process
- Provide insights and recommendations to the Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC), as appropriate

#### **Head of Staff**

- Provide direct supervision of the staff in their day-to-day job responsibilities
- Prepare and present annual performance appraisals for staff who report directly to the Interim Pastor
- Encourage opportunities for continuing education and development for church employees, setting attainable goals that are measurable and specific
- Work to develop the strengths and talents of staff and congregation to be of maximum benefit to the individual and the church

#### Moderator

- Moderate regular and special Session meetings and congregational meetings, encouraging open, honest communication and participation
- Work closely with the Clerk of Session, the Session, boards and committees, assisting
  them in carrying out tasks or missions, identifying areas which may need greater attention
  or support, and developing plans to make optimum use of resources and implement
  changes as needed
