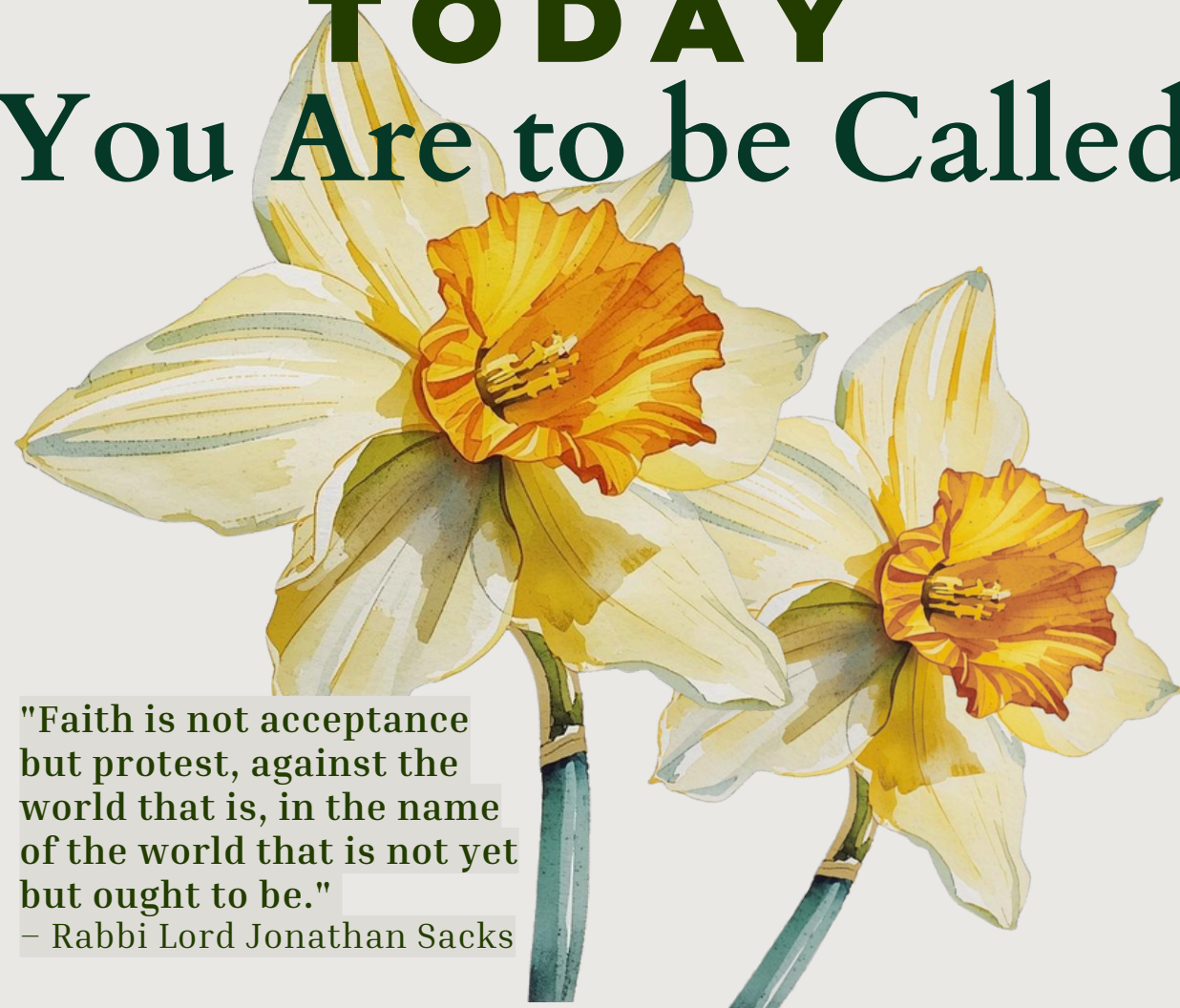

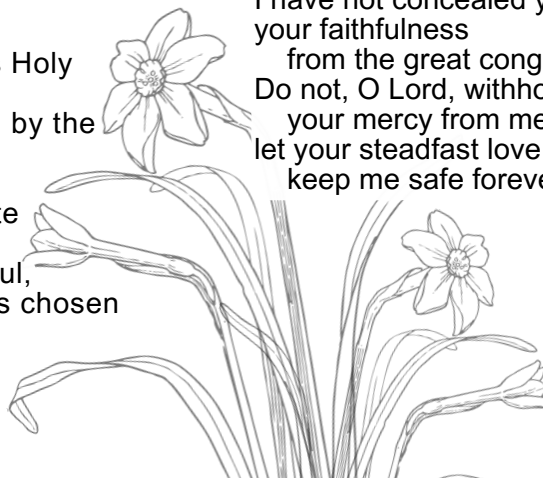

SCRIPTURE READINGS

Isaiah 49:1-7

Listen to me, O coastlands;
